VISION

Mental health is no longer taboo — it's at the center of the cultural conversation. This series explores extreme psychological states: raw, empathetic, and unexpectedly funny. These are not ordinary therapy sessions, but mental emergencies on the verge of breakdown.

PROTAGONIST

Dr. Frieda Elise Dom is not your typical therapist. She doesn't work in a practice — she works wherever chaos reigns. Her car is her office, and that office could really use a cleanup. Her personal life constantly bleeds into her professional one. She's a bit too blunt, has a terrible poker face, and can't sit still. But behind her chaotic exterior lies a sharp mind — and a wounded heart.

PILOT EPISODE SYNOPSIS

A famous metal band has locked themselves inside their tour bus for days and is threatening to break up before the biggest concert of their career.

At the same time, Frieda's doorbell rings. Standing there is her ex-boyfriend Alex — whom she hasn't seen in nearly a year. She stammers, searching for words — just as her phone rings: the record label is begging for her help. Frieda escapes into work, leaving Alex alone with her roommate Lotti.

Amid drugs, egos, and broken creativity, Frieda realizes: this band is no longer a band — it's a failed relationship. With her unconventional therapy, she gets them back on stage — and herself one step closer to confronting her repressed past. When Frieda returns home after the case, she's finally ready to talk to Alex — and face her demons.
